

Once there was a candy maker who wanted to invent a candy that was a witness to Christ. The result was the candy cane. First of all, he used a hard candy because Christ is the ROCK of Ages. This hard candy was shaped so that it would resemble a "J" for JESUS or a shepherd's staff.

He made it white to represent the PURITY of Christ and finally a red stripe was added to represent the BLOOD Christ shed for the sins of the world; the three thinner red stripes represented the stripes He received on our behalf when the Roman soldiers whipped Him. Acts 16:31 . . Delieve on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, . . .

Bromans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

My friend, this Christmas can be your best ever, if you will believe that Jesus is the Christ and receive the gift of everlasting life.

John 10:27 My sheep hear my voice and I know them, and they follow me:

Sometimes a green stripe is added as a reminder that Jesus is a GIFT from God. The flavor of the candy cane is peppermint which is similar to hyssop. Hyssop is in the mint family and was used in the Old Testament for PURIFIGATION and SAGRTIFIGE for the sins of the world. So the next time you see a candy cane, hear the sermon it preaches: Jesus Christ, The Good Shepherd, is the sinless ROCK of Ages who suffered and died for our sins.
