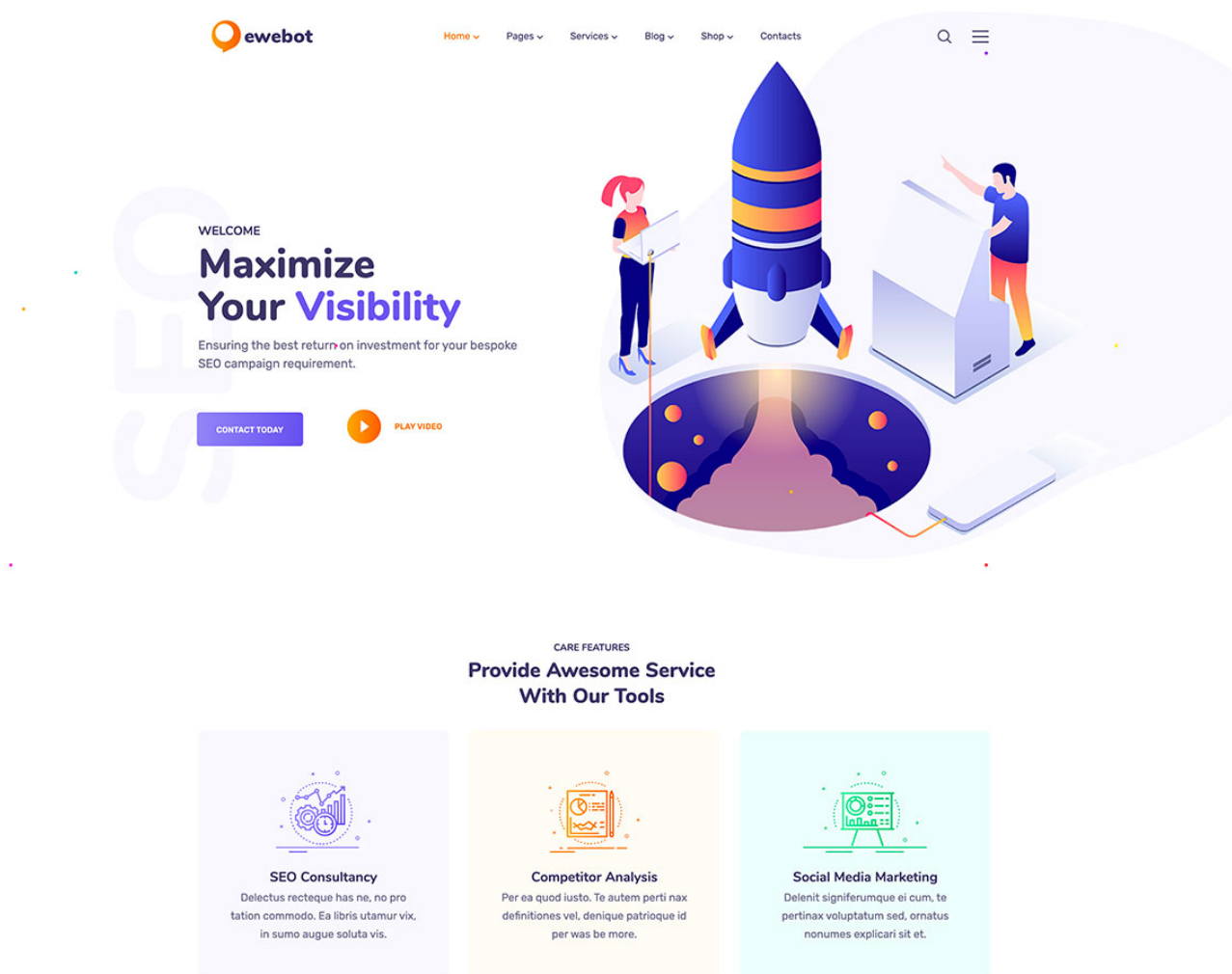

2. How to Install Theme

There are several ways to install WordPress theme, we recommend using FTP but you can choose other ways. Please read more about WordPress theme installation on the official website:

Upload WordPress Theme via FTP :

Step 1 – Please unzip the installable zip file that you’ve downloaded (ewebot.zip). In case, if you’ve downloaded the main zip file “**Ewebot WP.zip**”, please unzip it and use the installable one located in the following folder “Theme v...” ;

Step 2 – Upload “ewebot” theme folder to the theme directory (/wp-content/themes/) of your WordPress website

using FTP. You can use any FTP client to do that;

Step 3 – Log into your WordPress dashboard and activate “ewebot” theme in **Appearance -> Themes** section;

Step 4 – At the top of the WordPress dashboard, you will see a message ‘This theme requires the following plugins...’, please install and activate all those plugins.

3. Theme Activation

To get theme auto-updates and unlock all the available theme features, you have to register your theme purchase code. To do that, please open **Theme Options -> Product Activation** and enter your Envato purchase code. During the registration, the system will set up your personal GT3 account on [https://gt3accounts.com/app/\(https://gt3accounts.com/app/\)](https://gt3accounts.com/app/(https://gt3accounts.com/app/)) automatically where you will be able to manage all your purchase codes and get dedicated support. You will receive an email with your account credentials when your account is ready. Feel free to update the password at any time.

Important: To register the theme purchase code you must have the parent theme active (not a child one).

4. How to Update Theme

Updating your WordPress theme to the latest version is highly recommended, not only because it ensures you having all the latest features, but you’ll be up-to-date with any security patches.

Auto-Update:

If you want WordPress to handle theme updates automatically you need to enable this feature in the Theme Options Panel: **Product Activation -> Enable Auto-update On/Off**.

All the future theme updates will be available in **WordPress Dashboard -> Updates**. You will also see a new version of the theme in **Appearance -> Themes** section. To install an update, please click update theme.

Important: If you’ve modified the theme files code, all those changes will be lost because the old theme files will be overwritten with the new ones. That’s why in such cases we recommend using a child theme. How to use a child theme? Please read more

Uploading and Replacing the Existing Theme:

Before getting started you need to back up your database and your current theme. Since we’re replacing and updating theme files, there’s a chance something could go wrong so it’s better to keep it safe and have a backup.

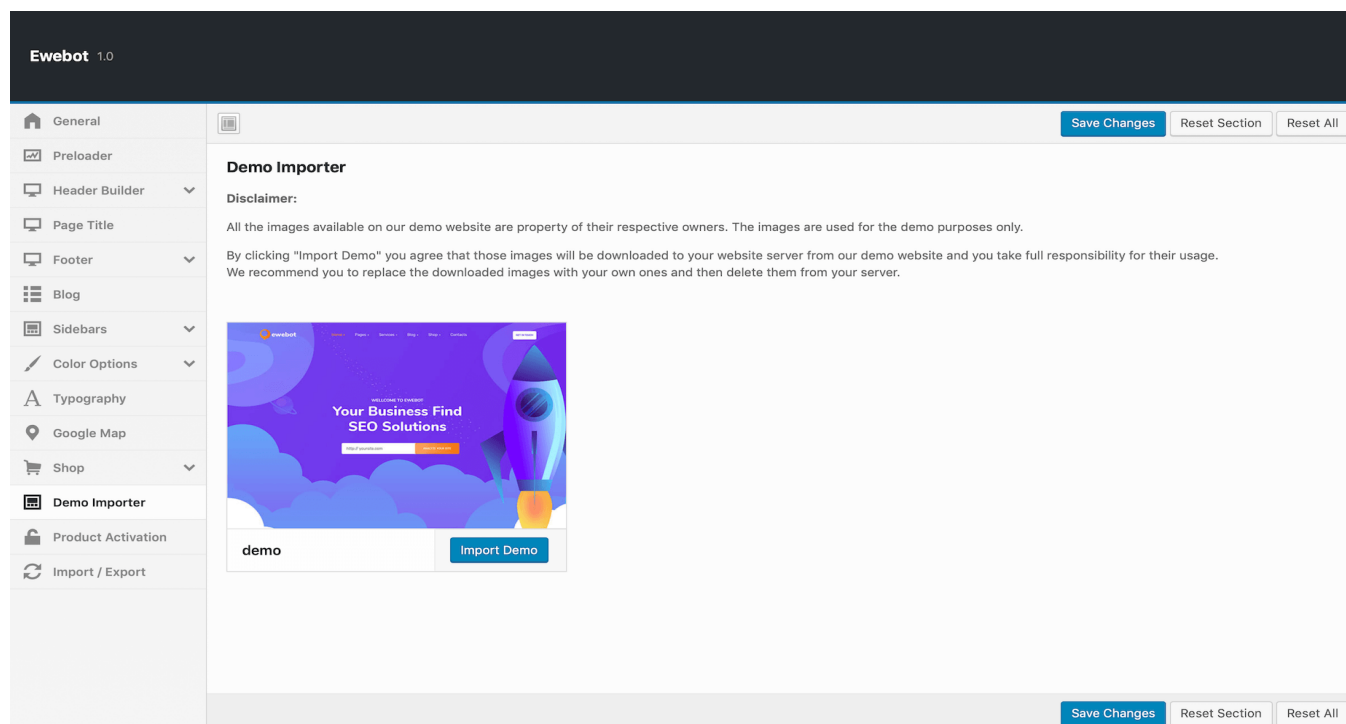
While using this method “uploading and replacing an existing theme”, please don’t go to **Appearance -> Themes -> Add New** and try to upload a new version of a theme with the same name, it will fail and you’ll get an error message stating that the destination folder already exists. The reason for this error is due to the fact you can’t have two folders in your themes directory with identical names (obviously!)

Connect to your website via FTP or log into cPanel and delete the old theme (your website data and theme settings won’t be lost, don’t worry) and then upload or add a new version. Make sure that you’ve made a backup

of the old version of the theme just in case something goes wrong.

After successful update, please log in to your WordPress dashboard and check if everything is ok. Newer versions of the plugins can be required, please update them either. If you have some questions or concerns, please contact us.

5. Import Demo Content



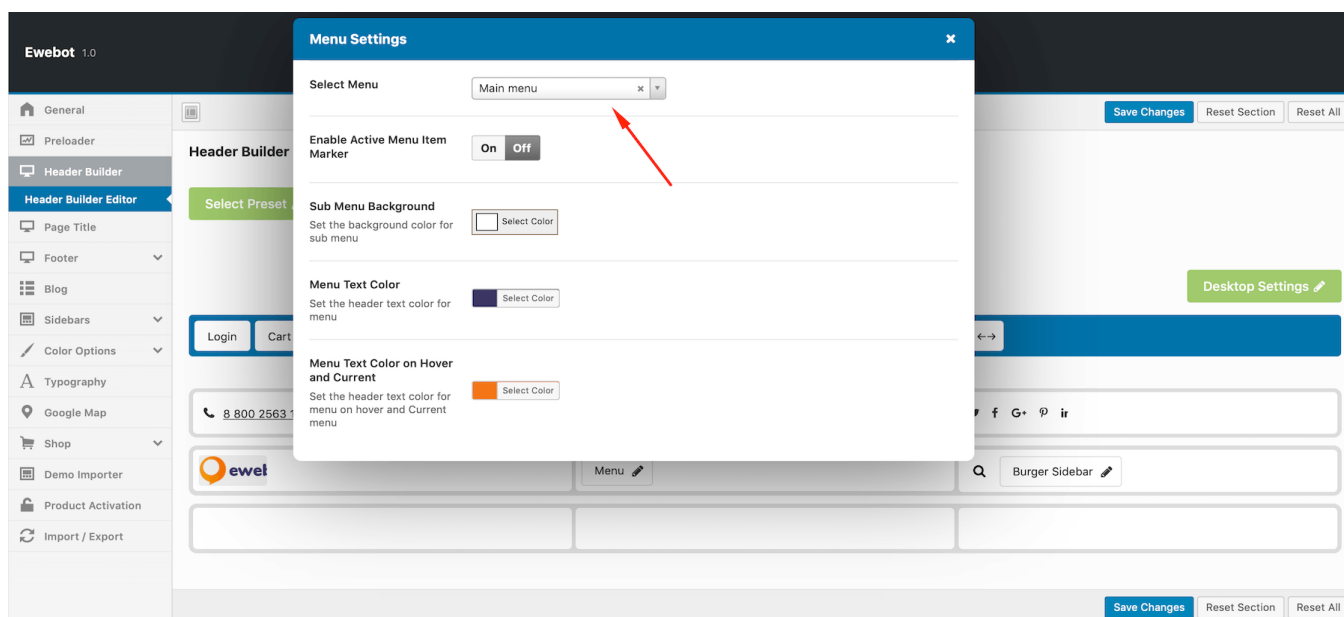
Main Demo Content Import:

To import demo content, please go to Theme Options Panel -> Demo Importer and import the demo content.

Once the process has been completed, please do the following (in case if the menu has not been set automatically) :

- Activate the existing menu, please go to Appearance -> Menus and select the "Main Menu", save the changes. The menu appears on your website
- To set any page as a home page please open Settings -> Reading and select the pages for "Homepage" and "Posts page"

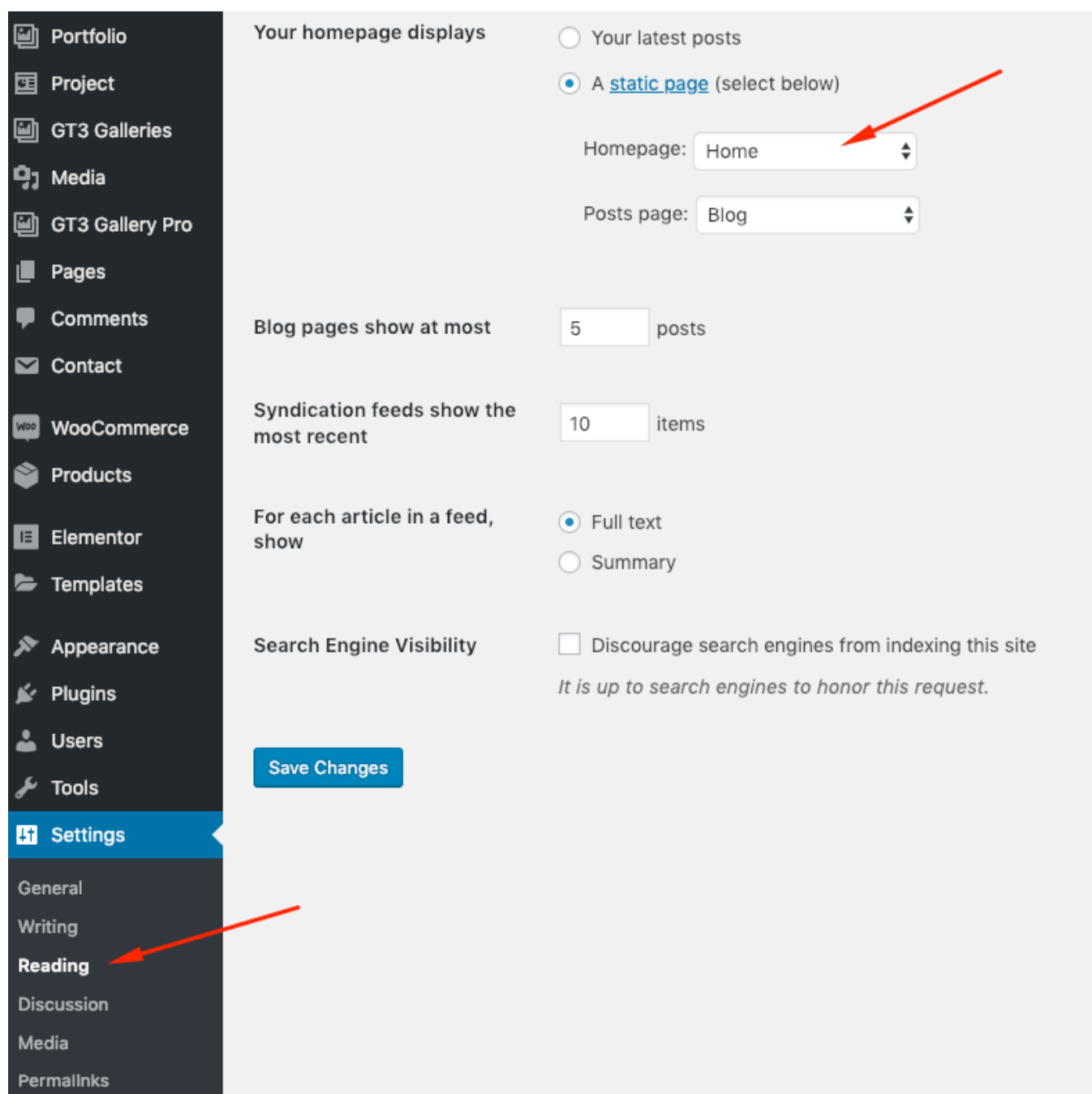
6. Menu & Front Page Setup



Menu Setup

Please go to **Appearance -> Menus -> Edit Menus** -> create a new menu by adding required pages -> click Save Menu button.

To activate the main menu – Please go to **Theme options -> GT3 Header Builder -> Menu** -> click the edit button and choose from the drop-down list in Select Menu one from the proposed menu lists (menus will be available only if you imported the demo content) or select the created one, click save changes.

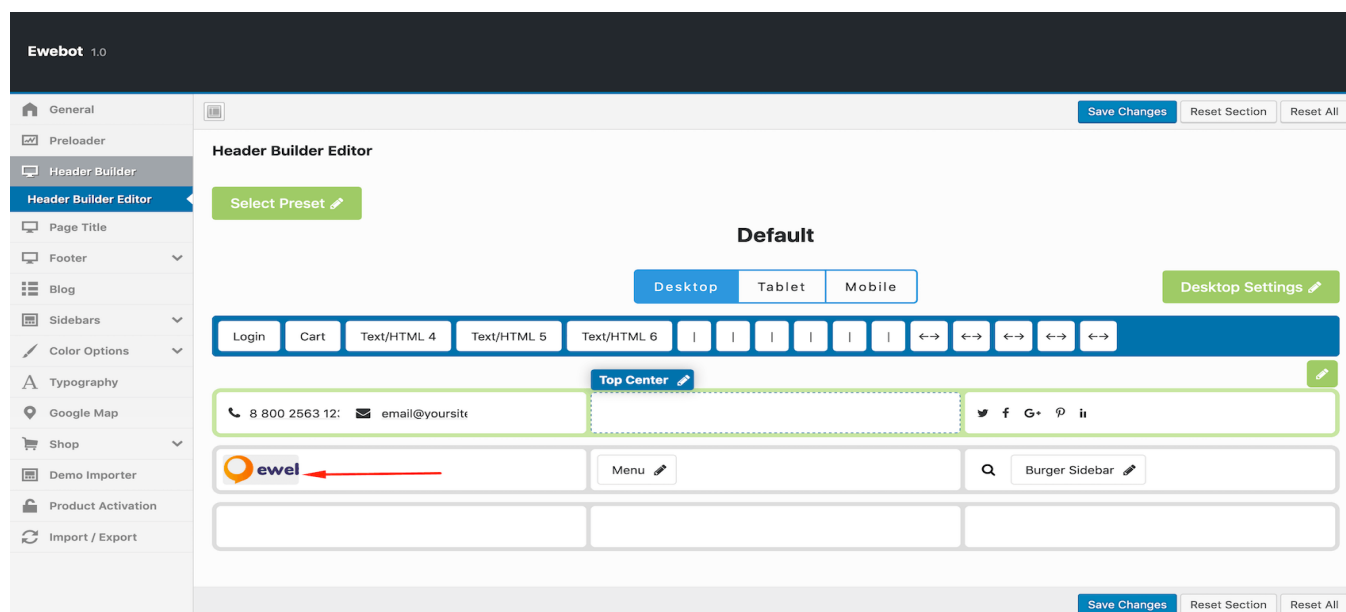


Front Page Setup

Set the page for the front page. Please go to Settings -> Reading -> Front page displays -> A static page (select below) set the page for the front page and save changes.

7. Adding Custom Logo

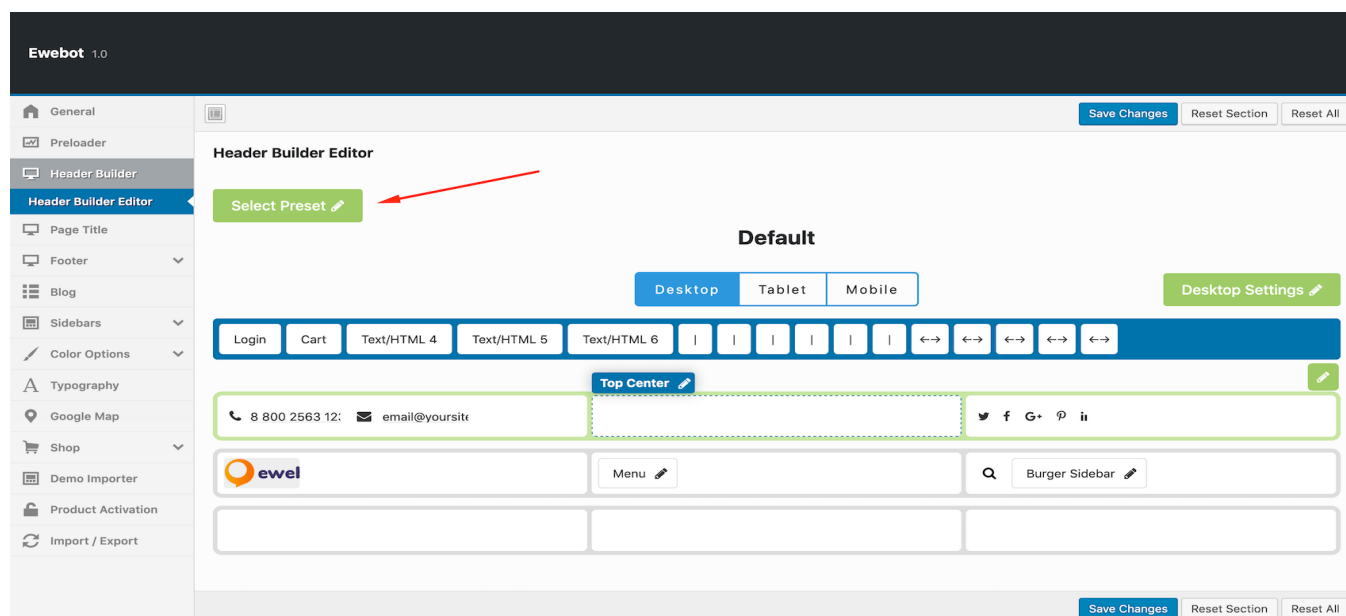
To add a custom logo, please open **Theme Options Panel -> GT3 Header Builder** section and click edit logo.



You will get a popup window where you can upload your custom logo. You can set your own logo height.

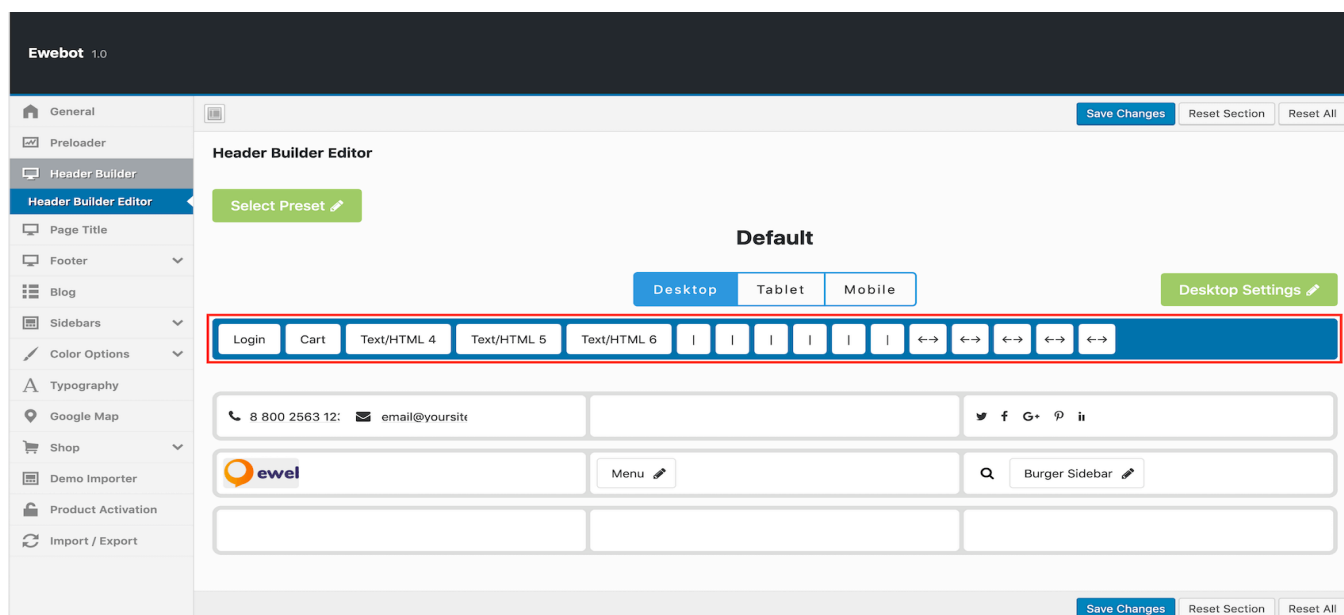
8. How to Edit Header

The theme has built-in GT3 header builder. You can manage the entire content available in the header via the header builder. The GT3 header builder comes with the **Header Preset Generator**. It allows you to create as many headers as you wish and set them for any page. To choose and modify the preset, please click “Select Preset” and select any header to modify.



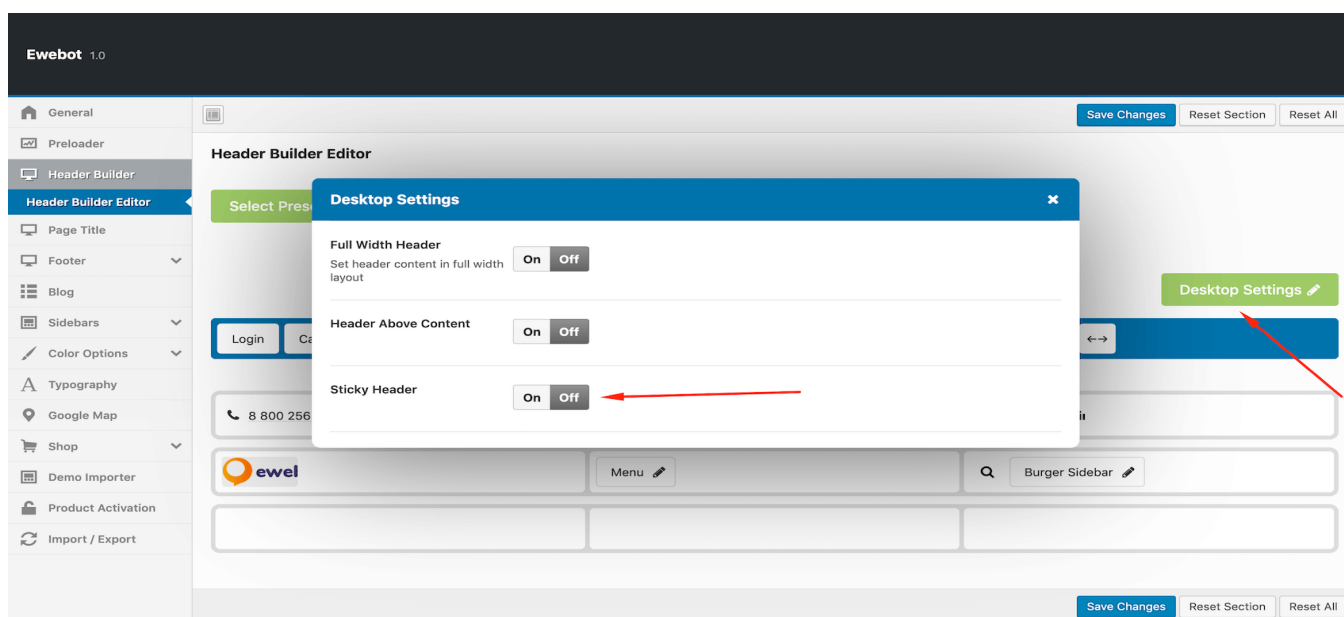
To modify the header content, please open **Theme Options Panel -> GT3 Header Builder** and any element.

If you want to add or remove the specific header element, please drag and drop it from or to the panel above the builder. The element “Text/HTML” supports simple text file format and HTML.



9. How to Enable Sticky Menu

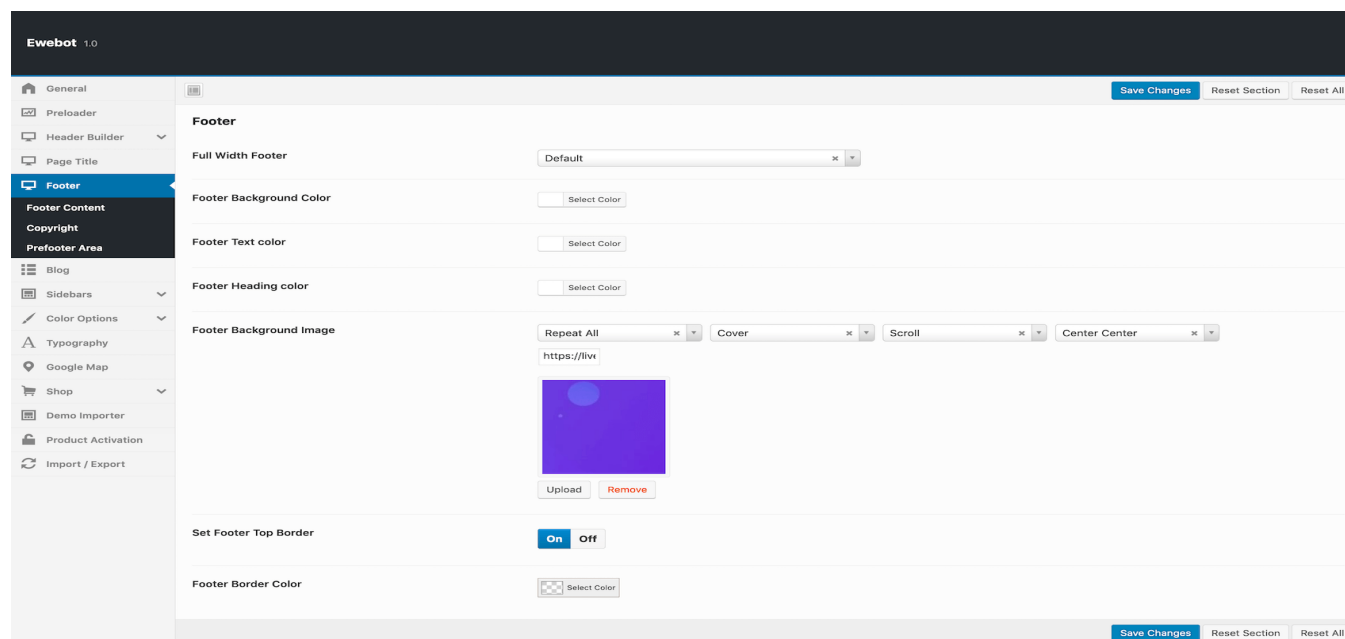
To activate the sticky menu, please open the theme options pane -> header builder. It has "Desktop Settings", please click that button, you will get a popup window with the extra settings. Please check the screenshot below.



Important: Please note that each header section has the option to activate the sticky as well. In the "Desktop Settings" you enable that option globally.

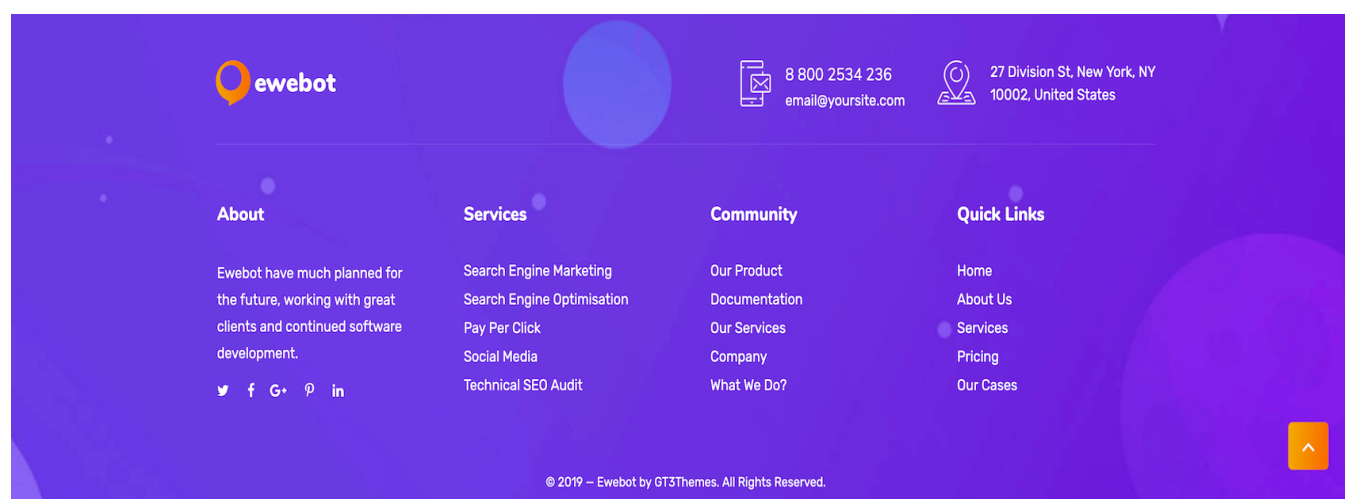
10. How to Edit Footer

The main footer settings can be managed in the **Theme Options Panel -> Footer** section. This section divided into 4 separate subsections.



- Footer – global settings for the footer
- Footer content – footer content settings
- Copyright – Copyright content section
- Pre footer area – allows enabling pre-footer area

Footer area – you can manage the content in the widgets area **Appearance -> Widgets**



Main Sidebar ▲

Add the widgets appearance for Custom Sidebar. Drag the widget from the available list on the left, configure widgets options and click Save button. Select the sidebar on the posts or pages in just few clicks.

Every single page has its own Page Options. You can use either the default settings available in the theme options panel or set the custom ones for every page. Please go to **Pages -> Add New**. If you scroll down the page you will see the following page options:

Page Layout: select Page Sidebar Layout;

Header Builder: choose the header preset ;

Page Title Options: adjust Title Alignment, show Page title or not, Font color and Background etc.;

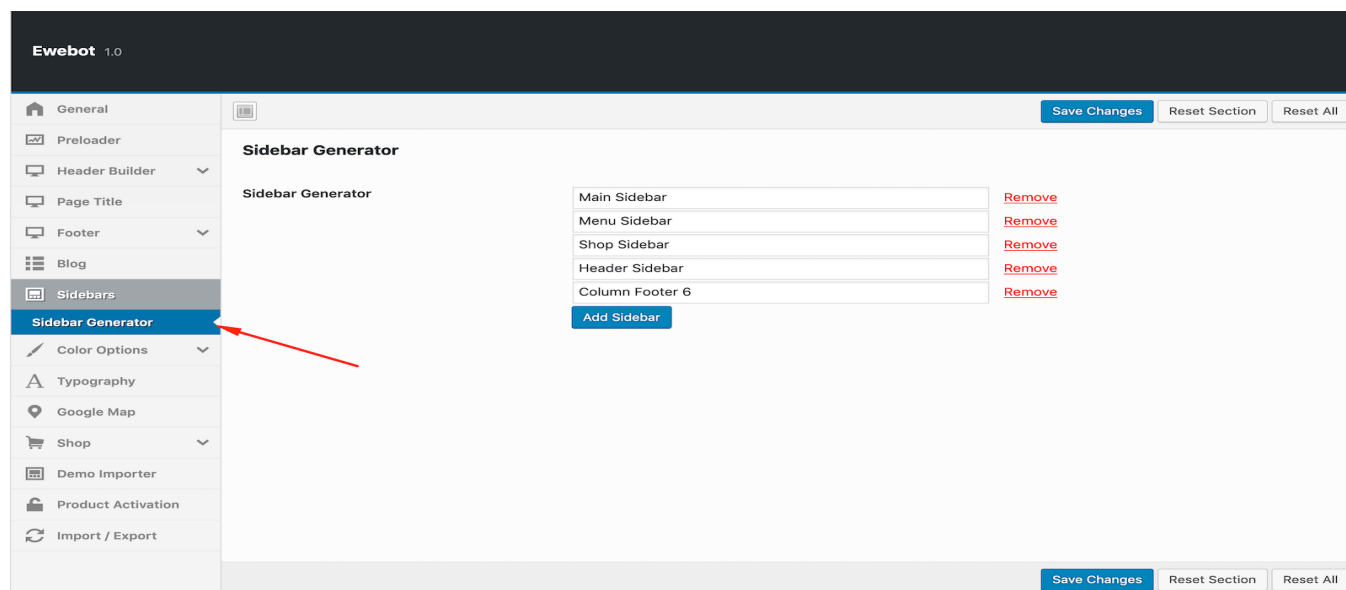
Footer Options: show or hide footer options, set Footer columns, Paddings, Colors, Image etc.;

Preloader Options: it allows you to use the default or custom preloader settings;

Shortcode Above Content: set a custom shortcode above the entire content;

Bubbles Options: enable animated bubbles all over the page.

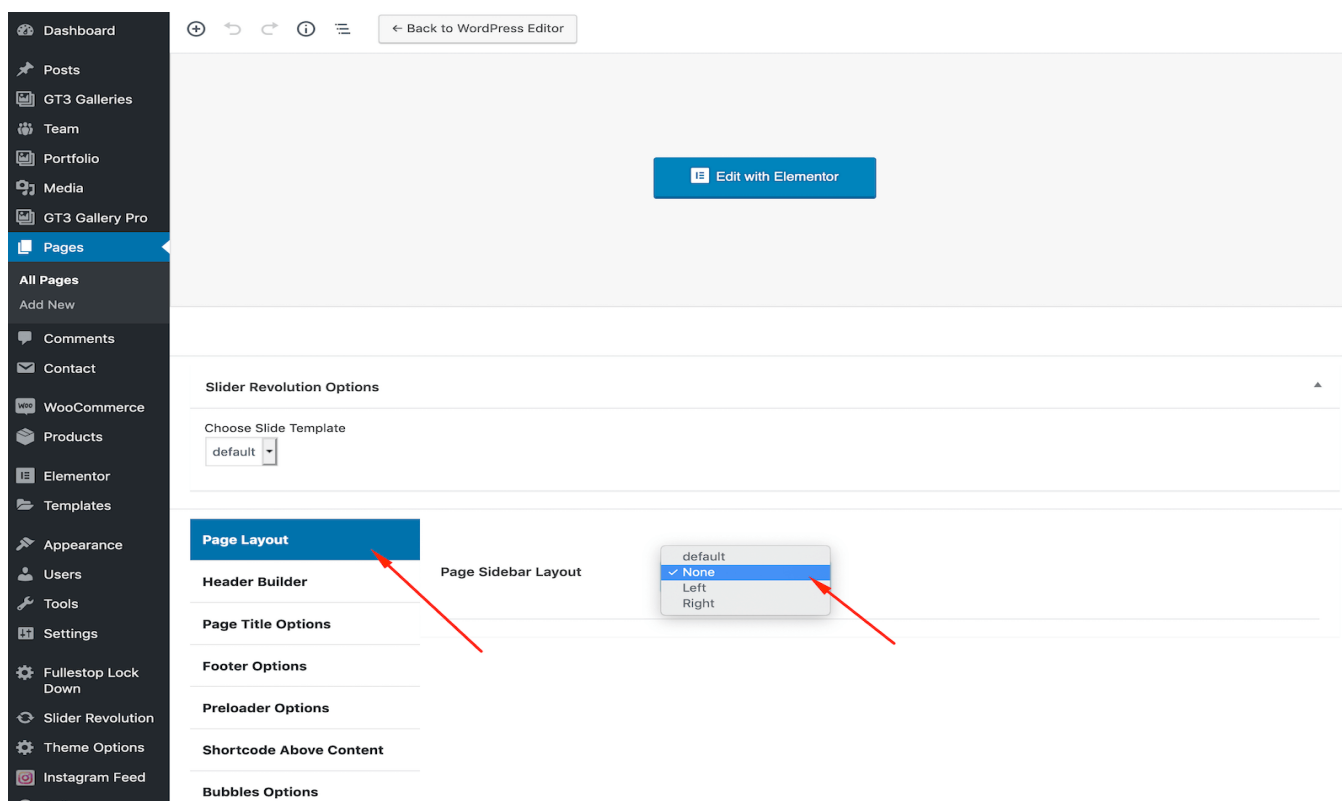
12. Custom Sidebars



Please go to **Theme Options Panel -> Sidebar -> Sidebar Generator** and create a new sidebar. Don't forget to save settings. Note, Custom sidebars available only for Default Pages. If you are going to use custom templates they will not be visible on pages.

Once the custom sidebar has been added, you can find it via **Appearance -> Widgets**. Feel free to add any widget to the custom sidebar.

To display the certain sidebar on the page, please open that page and choose any sidebar from the drop-down menu in **Page Settings -> Page Layout**



13. Translation Support

If you want to translate the website into your language, we recommend you to use Loco Translate which can be officially downloaded at <https://wordpress.org/plugins/loco-translate/> as well as to get official support.

In case, if you do not want to use any plugin, the theme comes with the translation files:

/themes/ewebot/core/languages/ewebot.pot
 /plugins/gt3-themes-core/languages/gt3_core_elementor.pot

Step 1 – please download this software and install it
<http://www.poedit.net/download.php>

Step 2 – please open .pot or .po file using poedit tool and translate the existing text to your own

Step 3 – when you save the file, you must name it according to your language

Step 4 – upload the file to the required folder on your server, that's all

14. Support Desk

- Make sure your question is a valid Theme Issue and not a customization request
- Make sure you have read through the documentation and support forum topics
- Try disabling any active plugins to make sure there isn't a conflict with a plugin. And if there is this way you can let us know
- If you have customized your theme or use the child one and now have an issue, back-track to make sure

you didn't make a mistake

Support for items includes:

- Issues arising from using any of the packaged theme features
- Bug fixing
- Any other theme-related issues

Item support does not include:

- Customization and installation services
- Support for third party software and plug-ins

Occasionally we will help with small tweaks, but these requests will be put on a lower priority due to their nature. Support is limited a time period according to Envato's (Themeforest) changes issued on September 1st 2015.
