Om. Triambakam yajamahe sugandhim pushti vardhanam Urvar-ukam-eva bhandhanan mritoyor mukshi-ya mamritat. Swa-ha

(We worship that One of divine vision who nourishes all living beings. May He free us from death and grant us immortality.)
