## THE GUTENBERG BIBLE

The Gutenberg Bible is the first great book printed in Europe from movable metal type. It is often referred to as the first printed book. The printing of the Bible was a monumental task that required the invention of the printing press by Johannes Gutenberg. The Bible was printed in 42 lines per page, with a large initial letter at the start of each chapter. The text is in Latin and is the Vulgate version of the Bible. The printing of the Bible was a major event in the history of the book and the printing industry.

It was individually one of the very first books to emerge from the press. The text of the Gutenberg Bible is the Latin Vulgate, known as the Vulgate, which was made by St. Jerome in the fourth century. The Bible was printed in 42 lines per page, with a large initial letter at the start of each chapter. The text is in Latin and is the Vulgate version of the Bible. 

