## A Sampling of Verses

Exodus 5:1 And afterward Moses and Aaron went in, and told Pharaoh, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, **Let my people go**, that they may hold a feast unto me in the wilderness.

Exodus 6:7 And I will take you to me  
for a people, and I will be to you a God:

Leviticus 26:12 And I will walk among you, and will be your God, and ye shall be my people.

Deuteronomy 7:6 For thou *art* an holy  
people unto the LORD thy God: the  
LORD thy God hath chosen thee to be  
a special people unto himself, above all  
people that *are* upon the face of the  
earth.

Deuteronomy 29:13 That he may establish thee to day for **a people unto himself, and that he may be unto thee a God**, as he hath said unto thee, and as he hath sworn unto thy fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob.

Joshua 24:16-18 And the people answered and said, God forbid that we should forsake the LORD, to serve other gods; For the LORD our God, he *it is* that brought us up and our fathers out of the land of Egypt,... And the LORD drove out from before us all the people, even the Amorites which dwelt in the land: *therefore will we also serve the LORD; for he is our God.*

2 Samuel 7:23-24 And what one nation in the earth *is* like thy people, *even* like Israel, whom God went to redeem for **a people to himself**, and to make him a name, and to do for you great things and terrible, for thy land, before thy people, which thou redeemedst to thee from Egypt, *from* the nations and their gods? For thou hast confirmed to thyself thy people Israel **to be a people unto thee for ever: and thou, LORD, art become their God.**

1 Chronicles 17:21-22 And what one nation in the earth *is* like thy people Israel, whom God went to redeem *to be* his own people, to make thee a name of greatness and terribleness, by driving out nations from before thy people, whom thou hast redeemed out of Egypt? **For thy people Israel didst thou make thine own people for ever; and thou, LORD, becamest their God.**

2 Chronicles 36:15-16 And the LORD God of their fathers sent to them by his messengers, rising up betimes, and sending; because he had compassion on his people, and on his dwelling place: But they mocked the messengers of God, and despised his words, and misused his prophets, until the wrath of the LORD arose against his people, till *there was* no remedy.

Psalm 50:7 Hear, O **my people**, and I  
will speak; O Israel, and I will testify  
against thee: I *am* God, *even* **thy God**.

Psalm 95:7 For he *is* our God; and we  
*are* the people of his pasture, and the  
sheep of his hand.

Isaiah 40:1 Comfort ye, comfort ye **my**  
**people**, saith **your God**.

Jeremiah 7:23 But this thing  
commanded I them, saying, Obey my  
voice, and **I will be your God, and ye  
shall be my people:** and walk ye in all  
the ways that I have commanded you,  
that it may be well unto you.

Jeremiah 11:4 Which I commanded your fathers in the day *that* I brought them forth out of the land of Egypt, from the iron furnace, saying, Obey my voice, and do them, according to all which I command you: **so shall ye be my people, and I will be your God:**

Jeremiah 24:7 And I will give them an heart to know me, that I *am* the LORD: and **they shall be my people, and I will be their God:** for they shall return unto me with their whole heart.

Jeremiah 30:22 And ye shall be my people, and I will be your God.

Jeremiah 31:1 At the same time, saith the LORD, will I be the God of all the families of Israel, and they shall be my people.

Jeremiah 31:33 But this *shall be* the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the LORD, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and **will be their God, and they shall be my people.**

Jeremiah 32:38 And they shall be my people, and I will be their God:

Ezekiel 11:20 That they may walk in my statutes, and keep mine ordinances, and do them: **and they shall be my people, and I will be their God.**

Ezekiel 14:11 That the house of Israel may go no more astray from me, neither be polluted any more with all their transgressions; but **that they may be my people, and I may be their God, saith the Lord GOD.**

Ezekiel 34:30 Thus shall they know that  
I **the LORD their God** *am* with them,  
and *that* **they, even the house of Israel,**  
**are my people,** saith the Lord GOD.

Ezekiel 36:28 And ye shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers; and **ye shall be my people, and I will be your God.**

Ezekiel 37:23 Neither shall they defile themselves any more with their idols, nor with their detestable things, nor with any of their transgressions: but I will save them out of all their dwellingplaces, wherein they have sinned, and will cleanse them: **so shall they be my people, and I will be their God.**

Ezekiel 37:27 My tabernacle also shall  
be with them: yea, I will be their God,  
and they shall be my people.

Daniel 9:15 And now, O Lord **our God**,  
that hast brought **thy people** forth out of  
the land of Egypt with a mighty hand,  
and hast gotten thee renown, as at this  
day; we have sinned, we have done  
wickedly.

Hosea 1:9-10 Then said *God*, Call his name Loammi: for **ye are not my people, and I will not be your God.**

Yet the number of the children of Israel shall be as the sand of the sea, which cannot be measured nor numbered; and it shall come to pass, **that in the place where it was said unto them, Ye are not my people, there it shall be said unto them, Ye are the sons of the living God.**

Hosea 2:23 And I will sow her unto me in the earth; and I will have mercy upon her that had not obtained mercy; and I will say to *them which were* not my people, **Thou art my people; and they shall say, *Thou art my God.***

Hosea 4:12 **My people** ask counsel at their stocks, and their staff declareth unto them: for the spirit of whoredoms hath caused *them* to err, and **they have gone a whoring from under their God.**

Zechariah 8:8 And I will bring them, and they shall dwell in the midst of Jerusalem: and **they shall be my people, and I will be their God**, in truth and in righteousness.

Zechariah 9:16 And the LORD **their God**  
shall save them in that day as the flock of  
**his people:**

Zechariah 13:9 And I will bring the third part through the fire, and will refine them as silver is refined, and will try them as gold is tried: they shall call on my name, and I will hear them: **I will say, It is my people: and they shall say, The LORD is my God.**

Luke 1:68 Blessed *be* the Lord **God of  
Israel**; for he hath visited and redeemed  
**his people**,

Acts 15:14 Simeon hath declared how  
God at the first did visit the **Gentiles**, to  
take out of them **a people for his name**.

Romans 11:1-2 I say then, Hath God cast away **his people**? God forbid. For I also am an Israelite, of the seed of Abraham, *of* the tribe of Benjamin. **God hath not cast away his people which he foreknew.**

2 Corinthians 6:16 And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in *them*; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

Titus 2:14 Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.

Hebrews 8:10 For this *is* the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: **and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people:**

1 Peter 2:10 Which [Gentiles] in time past *were* not a people, but *are now the people of God*: which had not obtained mercy, but now have obtained mercy.

Revelation 21:3 And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God *is* with men, and **he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, *and be their God.***
