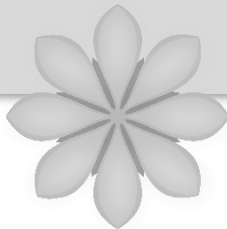

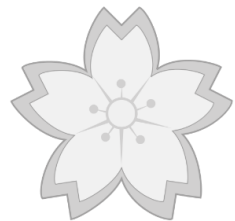
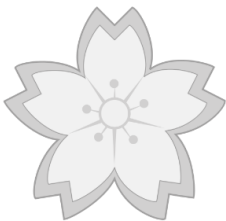
- C. He is always with me. (Psalm 46:1, Jer. 23:24, Psalm 139)

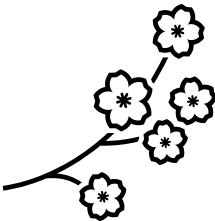

III. Knowing God's heart toward me, what should my response be?

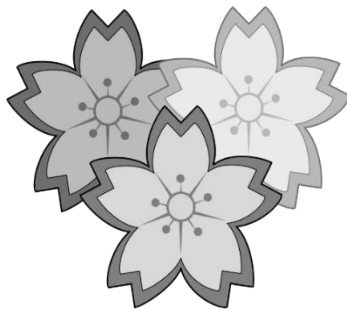
A. Communion

## B. Submission

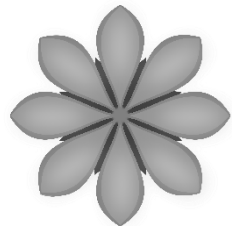
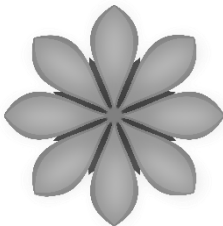
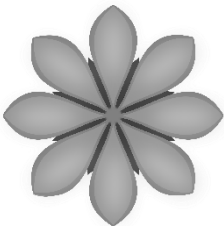
- 1) A recognition that God is the One who sovereignly chooses my path in life
