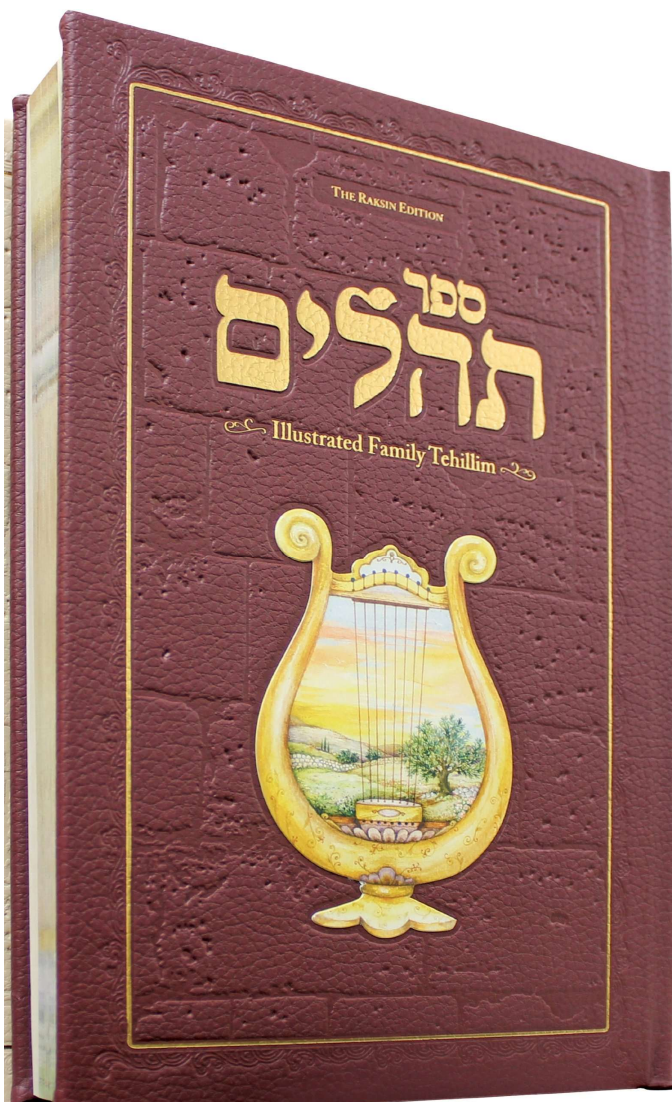

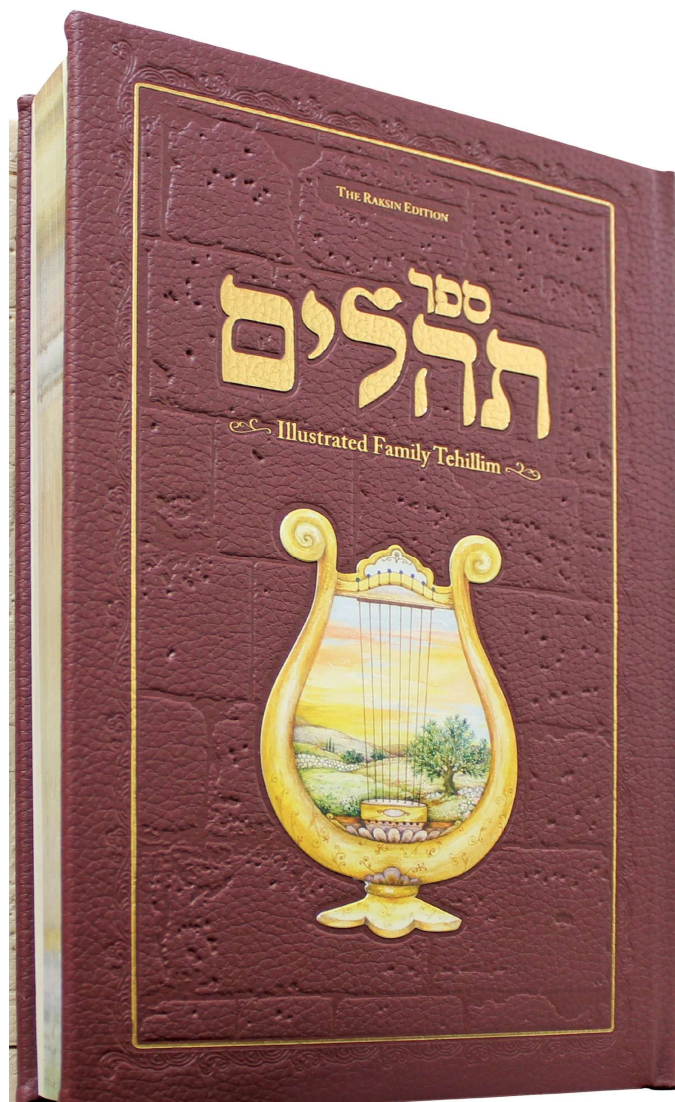
***speaking to one another in psalms
