They are presented by George J. Howard, of the British & Foreign Bible Society, London, to Motherwell Church, to be kept as a memorial of the great translator and of the blessings which God bestows on the English people by this earliest version of the Scriptures in their mother tongue. These two volumes contain side-by-side Wycliffe's first "Early" translation of 1382 and the "Later" updated version of 1388

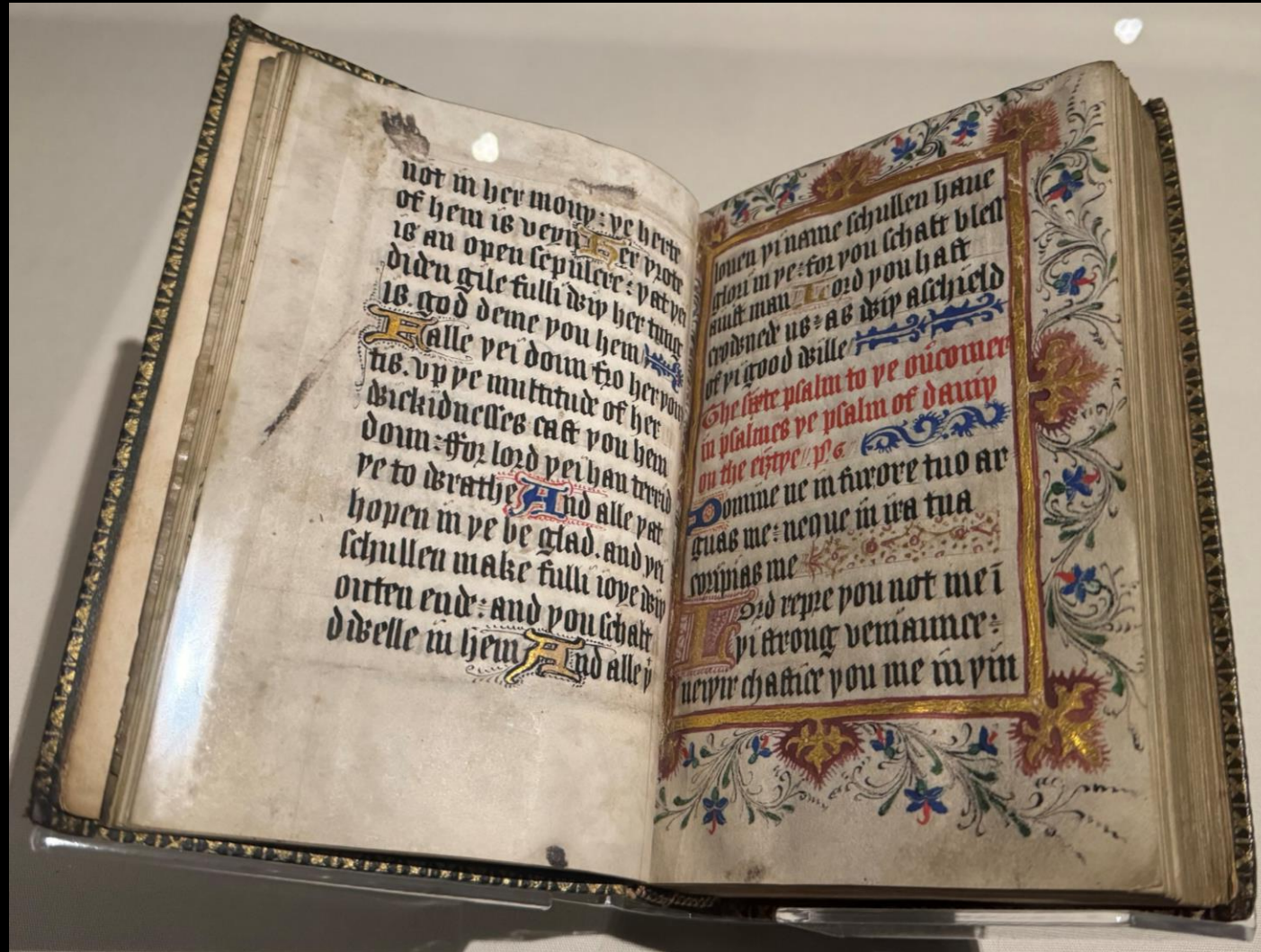

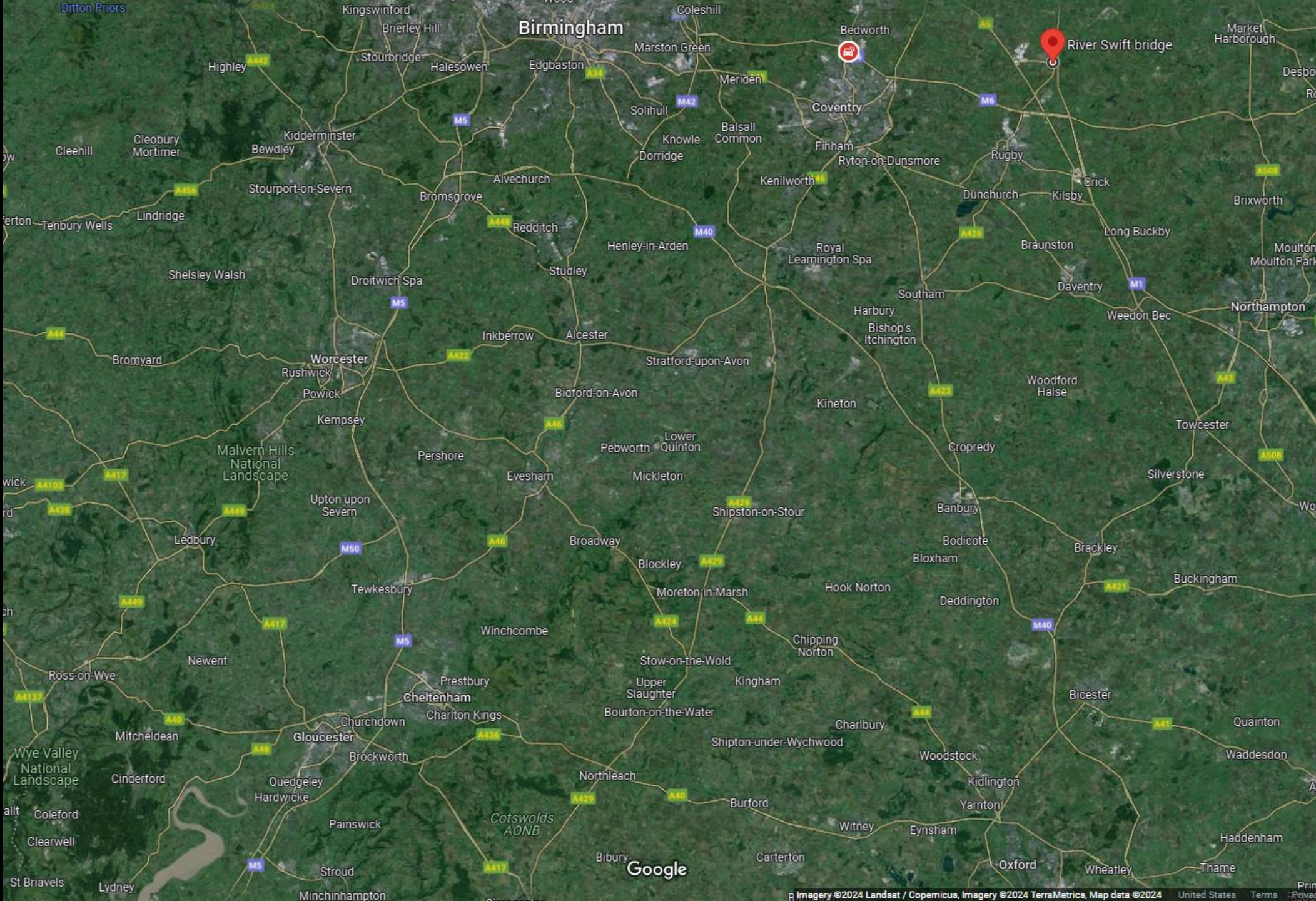




Wycliffe Psalter (c. 1500)


