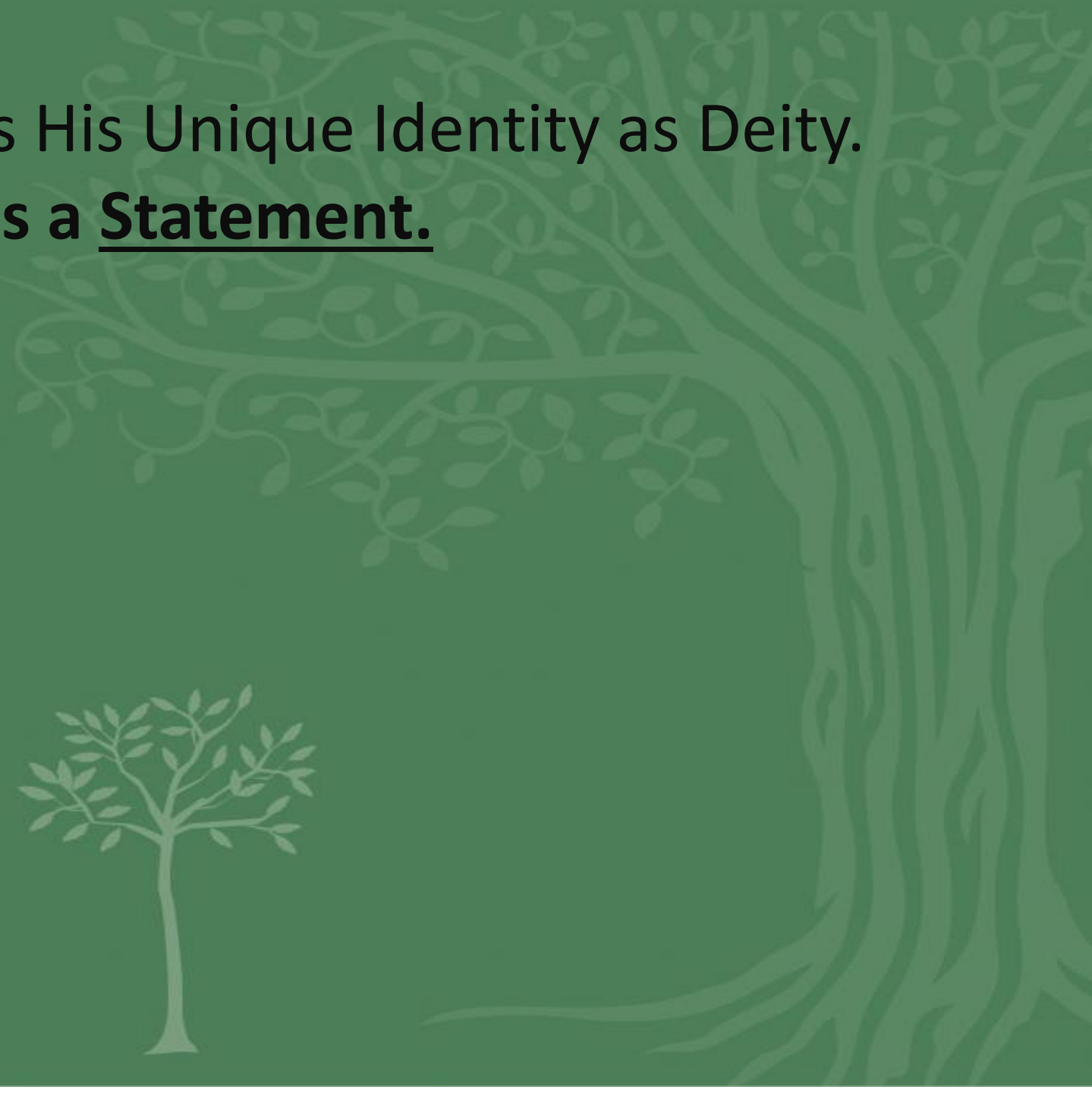
Translations uniformly translate, not *Lord*, but *LORD*, to indicate that this is the Divine name.

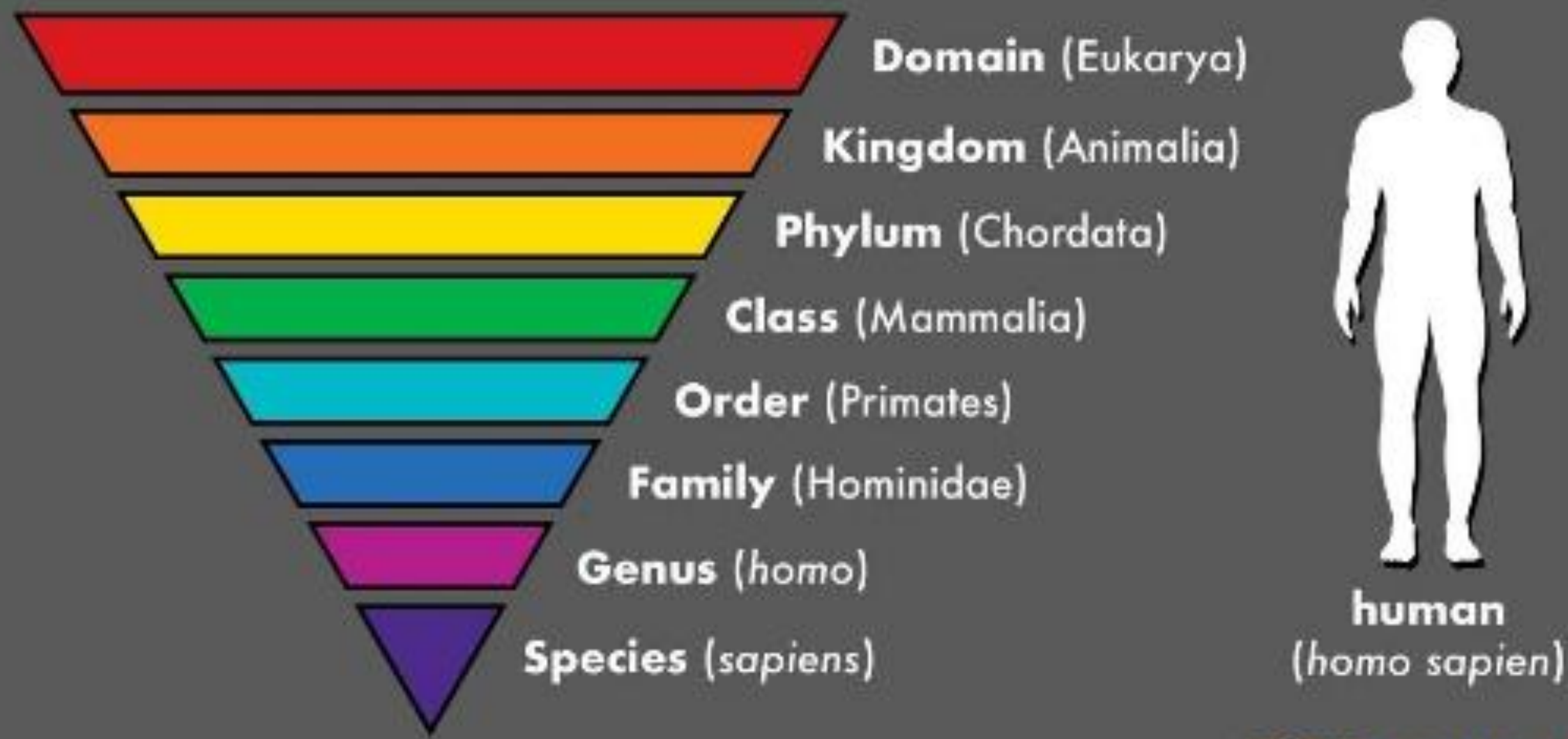
