52	Doeg misrepresenting (I Sam. 22)	Words (1-4)	God's lovingkindness endures all day long (1)	Entrusts himself to God's lovingkindness forever (8)
53	(Nabal (נָבָל); I Sam. 25) ???	Atheists (the נָבָל) <i>who eat up my people</i> (4)	God will scatter and put them to shame (5)/restore His captive people (6)	Anticipate joy/gladness (6)

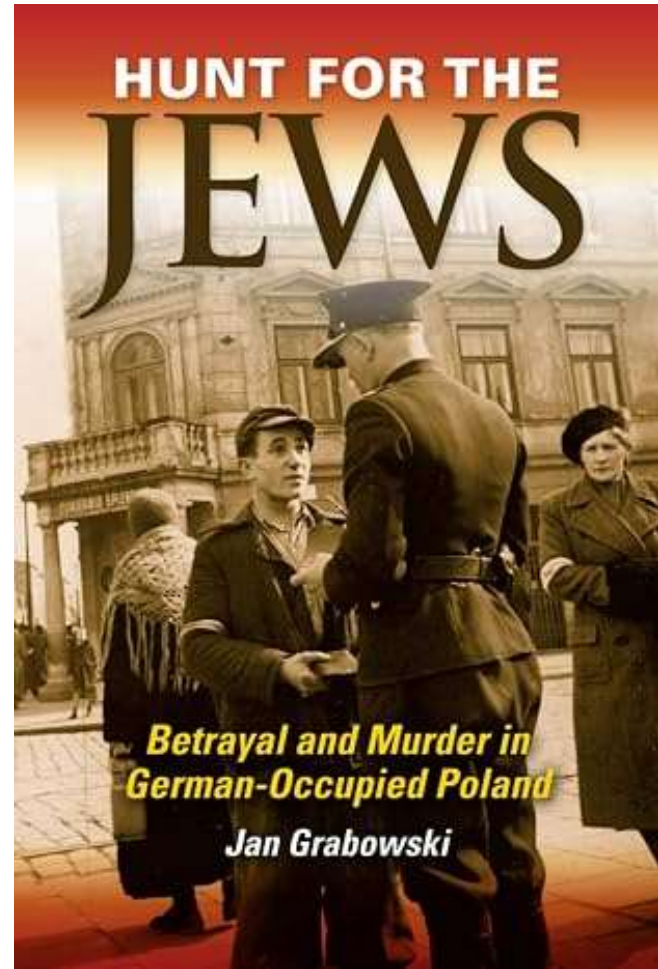
