3. What kinds of things can we do to remind ourselves that God is always working things out in ways that we will appreciate later even if we don't appreciate it now?
4. How would you respond to a person who thinks the way God has ordered His world isn't as good as they think it should be?
 - a. Is there a difference in the way you would respond to this person depending on if they were a Christian or not?
 - b. Why do we tend to pass judgment on God and His ways?
5. What does it mean that all things are from God and through God and to God?
 - a. Why would Paul finish the first 11 chapters of Romans with a statement like that?
6. How responsible are we for the good things in our lives?
 - a. All, a lot, a little, or none?
 - b. Why do you answer the way you do?
7. How does a passage like this make you feel?
 - a. Why?
8. Application
 - a. What do you believe God is calling you to do next?
 - b. What do you believe God is calling us to do next?
 - c. What do you believe God is calling us to do so we can reach non believers?
