

Discussion Questions • Hebrews 12:1-2 (NIV)

- 1. Why is it so hard to accept your race as your race?
 - a. Why do we spend so much time comparing our circumstances to others' circumstances?
 - b. What effect can this have on persevering in the race? (Hb 12:1)
- 2. Using the categories of people below, describe the aspects/details of their faithfulness that help and encourage you:
 - a. Who are some of your favourite Bible characters because of how they have been an encouragement to you due to their faithfulness and perseverance in running the race?
 - b. Who are some of the faithful Christians you know who have been an encouragement to you due to their faithfulness and perseverance in running the race?
 - c. **OPTIONAL** (If your group has been together long enough to know each other fairly well, ask the following question. If the group is very new, you may skip this question.)

 How has the faithful living of people in this Community Group encouraged you?
- 3. What are some of the things that hinder us in the race (Hb 12:1)?
 - a. How might we identify them and 'throw them off'?
- 4. Why is Jesus (with 'the joy set before him, he endured the cross' [Hb 12:2]) the key example to focus on as we run the race of faith?
 - a. How was his race unique? And uniquely beneficial to us?
- 5. How does 'fixing our eyes on Jesus' (Hb 12:2) allow us to properly view the race, the witnesses, the hindrance, and the sin?
 - a. If Jesus was not the focus of our race, what would it look like for Christians to try to run the race?

OPTIONAL: Based on our discussion, what is one thing you are willing to apply in your life for the coming week?

Wrap Up and Prayer; From your discussion, what resonated with you individually or as a group? Pray for each other along with other requests.
