- 2. How do you think the ministry of the Holy Spirit has been misunderstood by people?
 - a. In what ways do think you are open to the work of the Spirit or not open enough?
 - b. If you were to be more open to the work of the Holy Spirit, what do you think he would do?
- 3. Refer to the Trinity infographic (link below). Which part of it is the most helpful for your understanding of the Trinity?

- 4. Why would it be tempting for Christians to differentiate themselves as a 'Spirit-filled Christian' in contrast to a 'Word-focused Christian' (or vice-versa)?

- 5. Read <u>1 Corinthians 6:19-20</u>.
 - a. Why are our bodies important?
 - b. In what ways does knowing the Holy Spirit is in our bodies have an effect on the ways we make decisions about our bodies?
 - i. How will this knowledge effect what we do with our lives?
- 6. Read Romans 8:11, Romans 8:14-17.
 - a. What is the connection between the Spirit and us calling The Almighty God: 'Abba', 'Dad'?
 - b. How has the profound intimacy of knowing God as Abba/Father/Dad comforted you?
