- Survive monster “speed dating” (0% romance, 100% politics, you crazy fella!)
- Get judged by a magical harp-mimic that bites liars.
- Host a political debate where rugs might riot.

Either way, you’re ruining someone’s afterlife. Go team!



WHY YOU’RE IN THIS MESS

- **We Were Just Making a Map, Bro** – You were hired to chart potholes. That’s it. Lunch break hits, you blink, and suddenly ghosts are monologuing and your map is levitating mid-possession. 10/10 project scope creep.

- **Agent Blink** (from the Fey Board of Inspection) – Pixie civil servant trying to apply paperwork to an exorcism. Regrets everything.

SPOILER ALERT: WHO TO SUPPORT?

So you’re wondering... who’s the real hero here? Let’s check out the endings!

Team Fionola: You help resurrect her with cursed relics. Then she possesses you. You fight her but still get arrested for ghost war crimes. Yay! But before all that, you get a chance to threaten elven nobles like the biggest villain. Intimidate. Humiliate. Maybe throw in a spine-crack sound effect for flair. So... anyone here holding elven grudges? Now’s your moment.

Team Cristal: You host a chaotic debate, meme your way to victory, and help him break the Soulstone with a truth-harp. You kill the ghostly queen, he wins, monsters cheer, and you get shiny loot, land, and probably a title like “Minister of Chaos Vibes.”



MONSTER SPEED DATING TIPS

So you’re trying to help a prism tyrant get monster votes at a swamp rave full of weird delegates? Here’s your guide:

- **Animated Rugs:** Don’t step on them. Praise their fringe. Pretend you’re a rebellious area rug if needed.
- **Golems:** Fix their swamp Wi-Fi (a.k.a. leyline power grid). Don’t mention rust. Compliment their symmetry.
