Matthew 6:9, This, then, is how you should pray: "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name."

What it Means to Hallow God's Name

1) We have ACCESS to the name.

Names of God we have access to:

Jehova Jireh: "Our **Provider**" (Genesis 22:14) Jehova Rapha: "Our **Healer**" (Exodus 15:26)

Jehova Nissi: "Our Banner of Victory" (Exodus 17:15)

Jehova M'Kadesh: "Our Sanctification" (Exodus 31 :12-23)

Jehova Shalom: "Our Peace" (Judges 6:24)

Jehova Tsidkenu: "Our **Righteousness**" (Jeremiah 23:6) Jehova Shammah: "Our God Who is **There**" (Ezekiel 48:35)

Jehova Rohi: "Our Shepherd" (Psalm 23)

Psalm 16:5, "Lord, you alone are my portion and my cup; you make my lot secure."

2) We have **ACCOUNTABILITY** to the name.

1 Peter 3:13-15 (NLT), "13 Now, who will want to harm you if you are eager to do good? ¹⁴ But even if you suffer for doing what is right, God will reward you for it. So, don't worry or be afraid of their threats. ¹⁵ Instead, you must **worship Christ as Lord of your life.** And if someone asks about your hope as a believer, always be ready to explain it."
