## John 13 - Lessons Jesus Taught His Disciples

- 1) God's love is CONSISTENT not CIRCUMSTANTIAL. (John 13:1)
- 2) God's love causes us to BE LOYAL not to BETRAY OTHERS. (John 13:2)
- 3) God's love excels in ACTION not just APPEARANCE. (John 13:3-5)
- **4)** God's plan **FAILS OR FLOURISHES** based on whether enough people do their part **FAITHFULLY**. (John 13:6-8)

John 13:34-35, <sup>34</sup> "A new command I give you: Love one another. AS I HAVE LOVED YOU, so you **must** love one another. <sup>35</sup> By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."

## Managing Tension and Trouble

#### 1) EMBRACE Jesus' Impossible Commandment

John 13:34-35, <sup>34</sup> "A new command I give you: Love one another. **AS I HAVE LOVED YOU**, so you **MUST** love one another. <sup>35</sup> By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, **IF YOU LOVE ONE ANOTHER.**"

### 2) EXPERIENCE Jesus' Incredible Power

Matthew 5:48, Be perfect, therefore, as your heavenly Father is perfect.

1 John 1:8-9, If we claim to be without sin, we **deceive ourselves** and the **truth is not in us.** <sup>9</sup>If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

Matthew 14:28, 18:21-22

## Moving Toward Testimonies of Goodness

#### 1) FEELINGS must be honored.

Ephesians 4:15, **Instead**, speaking **the truth in love**, we will grow to become in every respect **the mature body of him** who is **the head**, that is, Christ.

#### Speaking truth without caring about people doesn't work!

John 11:34-35; Luke 7:12-14

#### 2) FELLOWSHIP in Christ love must be esteemed.

1 John 4:17-18, <sup>17</sup> This is how love is made complete among us so that we will have confidence on the day of judgment: In this world we are like Jesus. <sup>18</sup> There is no fear in love. But **perfect** love drives out fear, because fear has to do with punishment. The one who fears is not made **perfect** in love.

# God doesn't judge imperfect people-He perfectly loves and blesses them!
