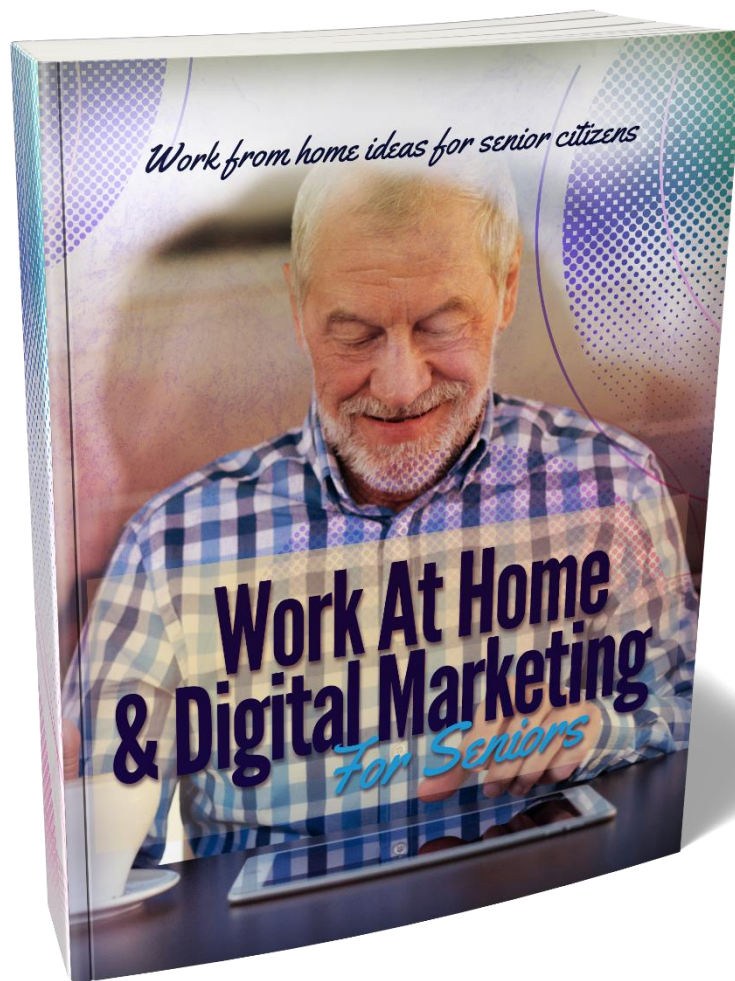

Compare this to the typical 9-5 job. You show up. You punched the clock, you work for 8 hours and then you leave. If you don't do that, you don't get paid. That's called active income.

Publishing a book, creating software, putting together an app, or anything else that can be downloaded and consumed by many different people over and over again, is passive income. Because every time they buy your stuff, you earn money. When you work, if you don't physically work or produce, you don't earn money.

There's no compass. Whether you are a retiree or you're still actively working, you might want to consider creating online income streams, that are completely passive
