

How To Add Prospects To Your Email List, AND Skype Group, At The SAME Time!

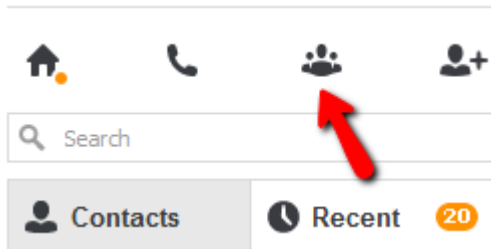


This is really quite easy...once you know how of course. ;-)

So let's jump right in!

Step One: Create a Skype Group **OR** go to an existing group where you are the creator.

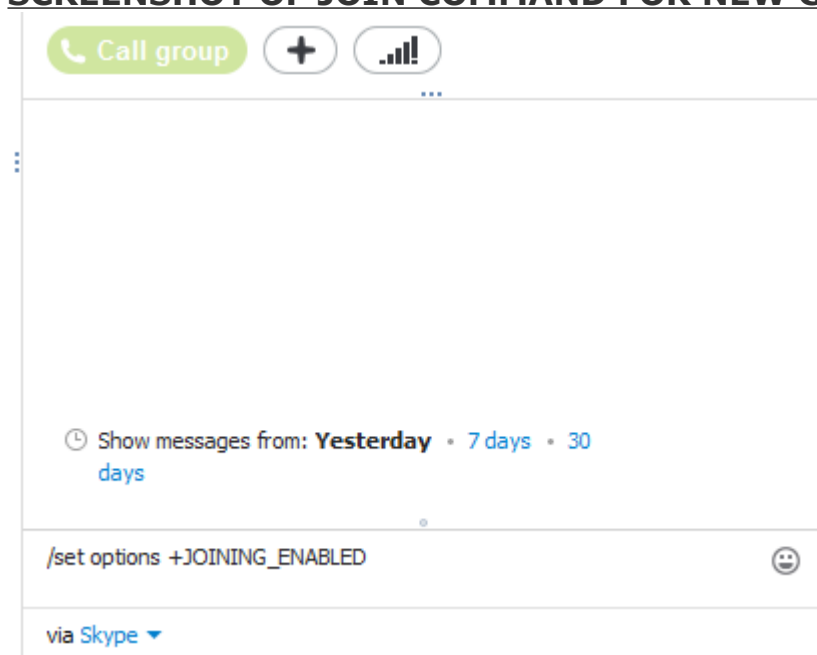
SCREENSHOT OF NEW GROUP CREATION:



*If creating a new group, type this command into the chat box of your group and press enter:

/set options +JOINING_ENABLED

SCREENSHOT OF JOIN COMMAND FOR NEW GROUPS:



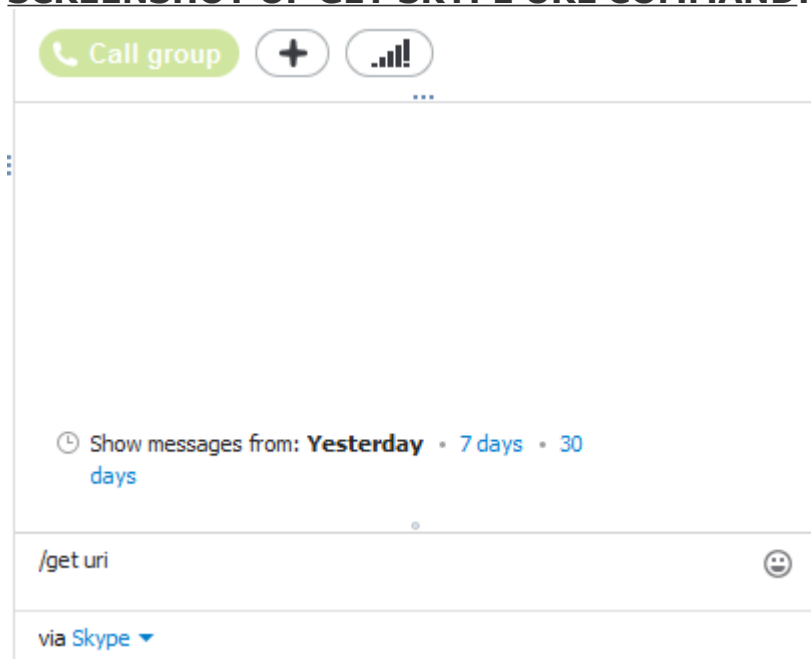
This allows new users to join your group by clicking on your Skype URL that you'll obtain next.

Step Two: Get your Skype URL

Type this command into the chat box of your group and press enter:

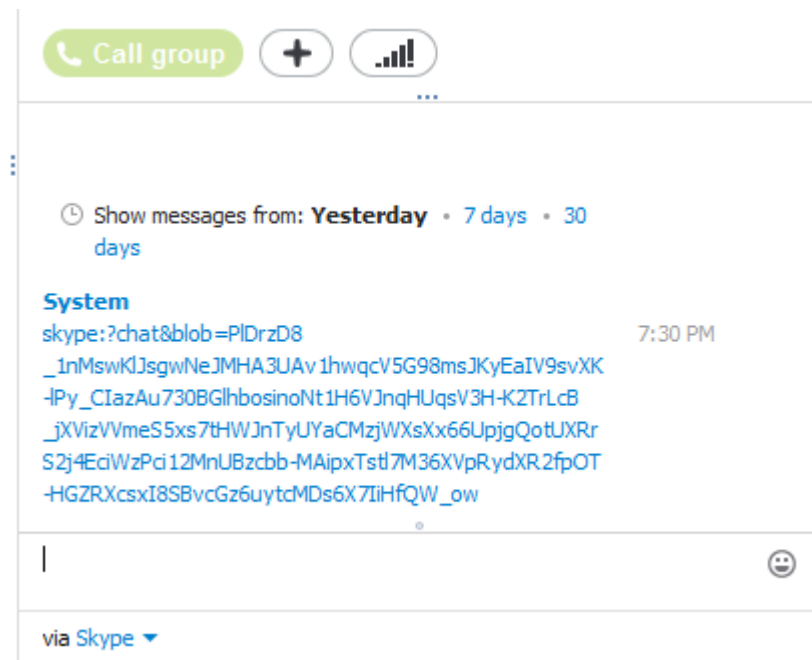
/get uri

The Skype system will generate a 'Skype URL' for you:

When a user clicks on this link, Skype launches (if not already running), and they are added to your Skype room automatically.

Step Three: Create a redirect link using the Skype URL you just got above.

Just right click on the Skype URL in Skype, and select "copy link location" to copy the Skype URL to your clipboard.

If you already have a link redirect/cloaking/tracking script, **AND** it accepts Skype links, then you're in the game!

I use the [Easy Redirect Script](#) by Jason Fladlien.

You'll have to test your current solution to make **sure** it's compatible with Skype links.

Note: MOST scripts and short url services that I tried while creating this report do NOT work since Skype URLs do not begin with http://

You'll know it's working when you click on it and it launches your Skype room.

If you get any errors, or the room doesn't launch, you can pick up a copy of [Easy Redirect Script here](#) which is guaranteed to work with this method, and the most advanced tool of it's kind on the market today.

There is a FREE alternative, and that's the age old <http://tinyurl.com>

Just paste your Skype URL into the box and generate a 'tiny' url:

Step Four: Create web form in GetResponse or aWeber.


On your form settings, choose **CUSTOM** thank you page after user opts-in.

Insert your redirect link you just made in the last step.

Save your web form.

Complete the form and hit the submit button.

You should now be added to your new email list, **AND** Skype should add you to your room instantly!

*You can also test your setup using another 'test' Skype account, or have a friend go through it - or both.

You're Done – HOORAY! That was easy enough right? :-)
